The Alliance exemplifies the initiatives envisioned in the French and Swedish Strategic Partnership for Innovation and Green Solutions.

The Alliance for Urban Sustainability is a platform to enable cities to identify and adopt innovative sustainable urban solutions by examining issues of common concern and exchanging ideas and experience.

Sustainable solutions for urban areas through partnerships

Innovation gateways

The focus of this topic is on sharing, testing and further developing methods for systematically driving innovation and involving a variety of different actors to support sustainable urban development. Network cities aim to share, study, test and adapt case studies, culminating in a best-practices report on systematic approaches to stimulating innovation that aims to improve urban sustainability.

Equity and environmental justice in urban efforts to address climate change

Conventional approaches to climate change mitigation and adaptation in urban areas focus on the physical and technical dimensions of the challenge, often resulting in negative effects on vulnerable social groups. The objective of this work is to define a more humanized concept of mitigation and adaptation and to examine ways to design environmental justice-oriented methods for testing by network cities.

Sustainable Urban Development Indicators

The network is developing a common set of indicators for exploring and communicating progress as leaders in sustainable urban development. Where are we leading, where do we need to do more work? The topic ties closely to the cities' efforts to address the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

Engaging citizens to promote sustainable behaviour

The aim of collaboration on this topic is to identify and evaluate methods and tools for cities to engage citizens in dialogue, focusing on:

- Educating and motivating citizens to influence attitudes and behaviour
- Enabling citizens to contribute to urban planning and development, to create contexts that 'make it easy to do the right thing'.
